Affordability

The Cincinnati region was ranked #1 lowest cost of living for major metros by the Bureau of Economic Analysis in 2019. The Cincinnati Metro Area's cost of living is 12.5% lower than the U.S. average. The median home cost is \$155,405. Home appreciation over the last 10 years has been 7.4%.

Amenities

Greater Cincinnati boasts major sports teams, numerous parks, museums, theaters, and free year-round festivals. The region has also been recognized for a thriving dining, brewery, and craft distillery scene. Accessibility

Greater Cincinnati offers a variety transportation options including the TANK bus system, Southbank Shuttle, Cincinnati streetcar system, and the Red Bike bike share program. Local residents and employees also spend less time in traffic, with an average commute time of 23 minutes. Situated at the crossroads of 4 major interstates, travelers can visit 27 major metro areas within 600 miles.



Diversity

The Greater Cincinnati regional business community continues to lead the way in inclusion and equal rights. In 2019, Cincinnati received a perfect score on the Human Rights Campaign's Municipal Equality Index. Greater Cincinnati is also the birthplace of the Minority Business Accelerator (MBA). Run by the Cincinnati USA Regional Chamber, the MBA is considered national model for minority economic development.
