## Neighborhoods

### Northern Kentucky

#### URBAN



**Covington** – Situated on the Ohio River across from downtown Cincinnati and extending south, features high rise, historic and new build living in a variety of neighborhoods with character including business districts, restaurants and coffee shops.



**Newport** – Urban, historic and new build living on the Ohio River. Newport on the Levee is a popular destination complemented by a historic business district with ethnic and traditional dining options.

#### SUBURBAN



**Triple Crown** – A premier community and home to the Triple Crown Country Club with a top-rated golf course. The community is convenient to shopping, restaurants and many of Northern Kentucky's largest companies.



**Fort Mitchell** - A quaint, walkable small town with historic homes, a business district, parks and top ranked public and private schools. It is often ranked a top place to live with award-winning public schools.



**Union** – A popular place to live and raise a family. Union has a variety of single-family home neighborhoods, quality schools and activities for children and adults.



**Florence** - The second largest city in NKY and one of the fastest-growing communities in Kentucky. Offering suburban living at a variety of price points with a family-friendly dining and shopping scene.



**Villa Hills** – A residential, suburban city along the banks of the Ohio River. Traditional planned communities include custom and single-family homes, townhomes and cottages at a range of prices. Businesses and services are geared toward families.

### Cincinnati

#### URBAN



**Mount Adams** – Perched on a hill overlooking downtown Cincinnati and the Ohio River. Features a mix of single-family homes and multi-tenant buildings with restaurants, a coffee shop and the Cincinnati Playhouse theater.



**Over-the-Rhine** – Revitalized urban neighborhood adjacent to downtown Cincinnati. Filled with murals, active nightlife, performance venues, like Music Hall and Ensemble Theater, and the large, public Washington Park.



**Northside** – An urban neighborhood not far from downtown Cincinnati, that offers historic, renovated single-family homes to urban loft apartments. Filled with murals, a business district and active nightlife.



**Oakley/Hyde Park** – Walkable, urban neighborhoods minutes from downtown Cincinnati. Each has a square with a lively business district, a variety of bars and restaurants and a mix of housing options.
